

Wal-Mart Grants

\$1,000 Available at Wal-Mart & Sam's Club stores! Most Wal-Mart and Sam's Club stores have budgeted \$1,000 for local veterans or civic groups. It is best to apply for this grant money at the beginning of each year, however it is quite possible that your neighborhood store might still have all or a portion of the funds remaining.

The grant application process is quite easy. You will need to fill out a short form to take to the store (link below). Ask for the Store Manager or the person in charge of grant funding.

Wal-Mart accepts your Post's 501(c)(19),(c)(3) and (c)(4) designation as proof of your non-profit status. You will need to provide the Post's 9-digit Tax ID (EIN) # on the form.

Grants can be used for a variety of activities such as patriotic events, outreach programs, aid to military families in your community and even Post building remodeling.
