National Headquarters has provided the Department with a limited quantity of the The American Legion National High School Oratorical Contest Chairman’s Guide that contains a suggested contest script, suggested news release and samples of forms used in the contest. Copies of the Chairman’s Guide may be downloaded from The American Legion National Headquarters Oratorical Contest website (<http://www.legion.org/documents/legion/pdf/oratoricalrules.pdf>).

The success and/or failure of this contest depends on you. Please see that the principal and/or guidance counselor of your local high school(s) is personally contacted in order to assure that every student who is interested can be contacted directly by a Post representative.

Post Contests must be concluded by **JANUARY 23, 2019**. **Post winners will advance directly to the Quadrant Oratorical Contest. No District Contests will be held.** However, your District Commander will be working with the Vice Commander to plan the Quadrant Contest. The enclosed certification blank must be sent to your **District Commander** immediately following your Post Contest. **District Commanders** will forward results to the respective **Vice Commander**.

All Quadrant Contests will be held on FEBRUARY 16, 2019. NO exceptions will be allowed except for inclement weather. Your Post will be notified of the complete details on the time and place for its respective Quadrant Oratorical Contest.

The State Finals Contest will be held **MARCH 9, 2019**, 10:00 a.m., at The American Legion Department of South Carolina, 103 Legion Plaza Road, Columbia, SC 29210.
